

Spherical Box

Friday Morning (8:30 am to Noon).

(additional materials fee approximately \$15)

Skill level: Basic turning skill levels.

Spherical Box with variations. Turn a 3" spherical box, and design consideration. This will involve a lot of special techniques that are used in turning boxes, and specialty jigs. The Students signing up for this hands-on this workshop should contact Ted via Email (tallensmith@netzero.net) approximately 2 weeks prior to the symposium with any questions:

Items to be made are: Spherical box; (specialty #2 MT live center if not made in morning class).

Students will need to bring the full range of turning tools (spindle and bowl gouges, cutoff, scrapers, chuck (1"-8tpi), spur center, tail center, calipers, face shield & glasses, dust mask, etc.

Plan making a lot of sawdust. The first ½ will be going over the basics, then we will get to work. We will use maple, sycamore or camphor. The additional materials fee for the wood will be due at the beginning of class, unless the student wants to bring their own wood (3 ½ x3 ½ x5 ½ " minimum in size for a 3" box.).
